


WORK PACKAGES















WP 2: Definition of an AI strategy in educational processes

- → prevent the exclusion of persons in disadvantaged situations
- → taking into account active learning, where the learner has a leading role
- → ensuring that AI4Ed activities comply with good practices, as well as legal aspects of ethical issues





WP 3: Identification of data structure

- → analyse the internal flows of information
- → analyse technologies involved in the already developed tools
- → guarantee data protection





WP 4: Capacity Building for teachers and students

- → define the programme that will support the capacity building
- → identify the areas of knowledge
- → create a proper syllabus





WP 5: Toolkit development and Use Case Implementation

- → Develop guidelines explaining what data is needed
- → Define and implement AI4Ed models in 4 different institutions
